


In the UK there are 10 Million people who are deaf and hard of hearing, 70, 000 of those people use BSL but there are only 695 interpreters.





## BSL Structure

## BSL is a visual language so you sign it differently than spoken English.

## When you sign in BSL your object or subject always needs to be first

## In English: The man stands on the bridge.


#### In BSL: bridge man stand

In BSL: field dog ran






In English: The boy climbs the tree In BSL: tree boy climb






